Conditions of Entry

1. The Australian Miniature Pony Society Inc NSW Branch reserves the right to accept or reject any entry without assigning a reason.
2. All ponies must be registered and upgraded with the Australian Miniature Pony Society Inc, and owned by a financial member of the Australian Miniature Pony Society Inc.
3. Any animal that has been bred or produced by the judge cannot be shown before that judge
4. Exhibitors enter on the condition they agree to abide by the show rules and the Code of Ethics, offensive language & behaviour will not be tolerated.
5. All ponies over 85cm must be measured prior to the commencement of classes on each day. Non-compliance will result in an ineligibility to compete. **Registration papers must be provided with Entry Forms.**
6. No late entries will be accepted and no entries will be accepted on the day.
7. All handlers/riders/drivers of ponies in the ring must be financial members to compete.
8. The onus shall be on the exhibitor to ensure that he/she is eligible for the certain classes he/she enters.
9. The Australian Miniature Pony Society Inc NSW Branch Committee reserves the right to:
 - a) substitute a judge at any time if the advertised judge becomes unavailable,
 - b) disqualify any pony which, in the opinion is in poor condition or unsound at the time of showing
 - c) adjudicate upon entry or upon dispute or doubt and to make any determination upon any matter and this decision shall be final and not subject to any appeal of any kind
 - d) alter the timetable and its content.
10. Neither the Society nor the Committee shall be liable to any person in case of loss or damage by reason of any defect, accident, negligence or neglect, however arising.
11. A protest committee will be appointed prior to the show. All protests must be made in writing and must be accompanied by a non-refundable \$50.00 fee. The decision of the protest committee will be final.
12. Competitors are NOT PERMITTED to approach the judge/s at any time prior to, during and following the competition.
13. Dogs must be kept on a leash and under control AT ALL TIMES where permitted at the facility.

HARNESSES

14. A novice harness pony/driver is one that has not won a similar class at a Royal or Agricultural or Feature show at the close of entries
15. All harness ponies must be 3yrs & over
16. The onus shall be on the exhibitor to ensure that they have enough vehicles for each exhibit entered, or that they have left sufficient time between classes to change vehicles. Classes WILL NOT be held up for entrants who have too many exhibits and not enough vehicles.
17. Every vehicle must have a competent driver wearing an approved safety helmet AT ALL TIMES.
18. A helmet must be worn by every driver whilst on the showgrounds AT ALL TIMES.

STALLIONS, COLTS, BROODMARES & FOALS

19. Stallions or colts are not permitted in children's classes or the junior driver under 18yrs
20. A Stallion or Colt shall not be led, ridden or driven by a person under the age of 18yrs in any class whatsoever.
21. A Broodmare is a mare which has had a foal within the past 2 years, who has a foal at foot, or is in foal (vet certificate required). If entered in the broodmare class, the exhibit is not eligible for any other class.
22. Only foals of the current season are eligible to enter, Born between the 1st August 2017 at the 31st July 2018.

INFORMATION FOR JUDGES, STEWARDS & EXHIBITORS

23. Handlers/Ponies are to be presented in English attire.
24. All Australian Miniature Pony exhibits are to be judged in accordance with the Australian Miniature Pony Society Inc Standard of Excellence.
25. All exhibits will be given a workout.
26. Where an awarded exhibit is subsequently disqualified, all placings shall be adjusted as if that exhibit was not judged and the exhibit with the next highest score/placing shall fill the vacant position.
27. Exhibits eligible for Grand Champion Miniature Pony of Show & Runner-Up Grand Champion are the winners of Supreme Mare, Filly, Stallion, Colt & Gelding classes.
28. Exhibits eligible for Grand Champion Appendix Aust. Miniature Pony of Show are winners of Supreme Gelding, Mare/Filly, Stallion/Colt
29. Exhibits eligible for Best Youngstock of Show are the winners of the Supreme Colt, Supreme Filly & Supreme Junior Gelding.

AUSTRALIAN MINIATURE PONY ne 87cms DUAL REGISTERED CLASSES

30. All exhibits must be registered with both the Australian Miniature Pony Society Inc and the Australian Pony Stud Book Society Inc.
31. Photocopies of Registration papers from both Societies must accompany entries.
32. Wins gained in these classes are not eligible to be used as qualifications for ANY other shows

AUSTRALIAN MINIATURE PONY SWEEPSTAKES

33. Open to all registered ponies (appendix not included).
34. Ponies of any age are eligible to compete.
35. All ponies are to be given a workout, to be judged by 2 judges based on a pointscore:
 - a) Conformation = 10 points
 - b) Presentation = 5 points
 - c) Manners = 5 points
 - d) Movement/action = 10 pointsTotal score out of 30 points.
36. The pony with the highest score will receive 1st, the next highest will receive 2nd, etc etc
37. In the event of a tie, the judges will be asked to select a winner or declare the pony with the highest points for conformation as the winner. Should a tie still result, this will be conducted for movement/action, presentation, and then the 3 judges collaborate.
38. There is no restriction on the number of ponies shown by one handler. All ponies need a handler who is a financial member for the final presentation.
39. Prizes;
 - 1st = 40% of entry money
 - 2nd = 20% of entry money
 - 3rd = 10% of entry moneySpecial Sashes to 5th place.

HANDLER AUSTRALIAN MINIATURE PONY SWEEPSTAKES

40. Open to Handlers and registered ponies (appendix not included).
41. Ponies of any age are eligible to compete.
42. All handlers are to be given a workout, to be judged by 2 judges based on a pointscore:
 - a) Presentation = 5 points
 - b) Manners = 10 points
 - c) Execution of Workout = 10 pointsTotal score out of 30 points.
43. The handler with the highest score will receive 1st, the next highest will receive 2nd, etc etc
44. In the event of a tie, the judges will be asked to select a winner or declare the pony with the highest points for workout as the winner. Should a tie still result, this will be conducted for manners, presentation and then the 3 judges collaborate.
45. Prizes;
 - 1st = 40% of entry money
 - 2nd = 20% of entry money
 - 3rd = 10% of entry moneyPlacing's to 5th place.

NSW Australian Miniature Pony of the Year Rules

Exhibits and Handlers Eligibility

1. Exhibits must be registered with the Australian Miniature Pony Society Inc. and owned by current financial members
2. Handlers must be members of the Australian Miniature Pony Society Inc.
3. Exhibits and handlers eligible to compete are required to qualify by winning one of the following:
 - a. A Champion and/or Reserve Champion or 1st in a Foal Class at either the i) 2017 NSW Championship State Show; ii) 2017 NSW Southern Districts Championship Show; iii) 2018 NSW Northern Districts Championship Show; and/or iv) 2018 NSW Western Districts Championship Show
 - b. 1st Place at the 2018 Sydney Royal Easter Show
 - c. Champion or Reserve Champion at any Royal Show in Australia; and/or
 - d. Champion or Reserve Champion at any Australian Miniature Pony Society Show within Australia outside of NSW (i.e. VIC, SA, WA, TAS or QLD).
 - e. Where there are no AMPS run shows available (statewide, outside of NSW) for exhibitors to obtain qualifications, a minimum of 3 Supreme awards at Agricultural or Breed shows may be accepted, subject to application form being submitted.
4. Exhibits and handlers that have qualified at any of the Australian Miniature Pony Society Inc. NSW Branch Shows and Sydney Royal Easter Show will be sent an invitation letter
5. Exhibits and handlers that have qualified at events other than the Australian Miniature Pony Society Inc. NSW Branch Shows and the Sydney Royal Easter Show can submit an entry application form (available online at www.nswminiaturepony.com.au)
6. Acceptance Forms are required to be completed and submitted with an entry fee of \$15.00 per qualifier, NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AND NO REFUNDS AVAILABLE AFTER THE CLOSING DATE
7. Ponies who qualified as a 3yo Colt, Filly or Junior Gelding during the 2017/2018 Show Season will be judged as a Senior for the Australian Miniature Pony of the Year Awards in the 2017/2018 Show Season.
8. Ponies who qualified as a foal during the 2017/2018 Show Season will be judged as a Junior for the Australian Miniature of the Year Awards in the 2017/2018 Show Season.
9. Male foals, Colts or Stallions that have been gelded are eligible to be transferred to the relevant Gelding Class.

Judging

10. Three judges will be officiating for all classes
11. Every Pony and Handler in all classes will be given a workout.
12. Judging of the Australian Miniature Pony of the Year will be based on a point score
 - a. Conformation: 10 points
 - b. Presentation: 5 points
 - c. Temperament: 5 points
 - d. Action/Movement: 10 points
 - e. Total of 30 points
13. The pony with the overall highest score in each division (stallion or colt, mare or filly, gelding) will receive their respective Australian Miniature Pony of the Year title, and the pony with the highest overall score will receive the Overall Australian Miniature Pony of the Year title.
 - a. In the event of a tie between two or more ponies, the judges will be asked to select a winner or declare the pony with the highest points for conformation as the winner.
 - b. Should a tie still result between two or more ponies from the conformation points, the pony with the highest points for action/movement will be declared the winner.
 - c. Should a tie still result between two or more ponies from the conformation and action/movement points, the pony with the highest points for presentation will be declared the winner.
 - d. Should a tie still result, the pony with the highest points for manners will be declared the winner.
 - e. Should a tie still result between two or more ponies from the four sections, the judges will be asked to select a winner, etc.
14. The Australian Miniature Pony Handler of the Year will be judge by three judges based on a point score:
 - a. Handling of Pony: 10 points
 - b. Presentation: 5 points
 - c. Total of 15 points
15. The Handler with the overall highest score will be awarded the Australian Miniature Pony Handler of the Year title, the 2nd highest scored handler will receive the Runner-Up Australian Miniature Pony Handler of the Year title
 - a. In the event of a tie between two or more handlers, the judges will be asked to select a winner or declare the handler with the highest points for Handling of Pony will be declared the winner
 - b. In the event of a tie between two or more handlers from the Handling of Pony points, the Handler with the highest score for presentation will be declared the winner
 - c. In the event of a tie between two or more handlers from the Handling of Pony and Presentation points, the judges will be asked to select a winner, etc.
16. Judging of the NSW Appendix Australian Miniature Pony of the Year will be conducted as outlined in point 15.
17. The Australian Miniature Pony in Harness of the Year Class will be judged on a pointscore with the overall highest score winning the Title and the 2nd Highest score receiving runner-up. The pointscore is as follows:
 - a. Workout (set): 10 points
 - b. Action/Movement: 10 points
 - c. Temperament: 5 points
 - d. Presentation: 5 points
 - e. Turnout: 5 points
 - f. Conformation: 5 points
 - g. Total: 40 points

OPTIONS

The NSW Branch Committee has included the following options to reduce the costs for exhibitors at the NSW Championship State Show.

- Members can nominate for one exhibit number to be allocated per pony for the showing life of the pony. A \$10.00 deposit is required and will be refunded once the number is returned to the Events Coordinator. Numbers must be in good condition, the deposit will be forfeited if the number plates are broken or unusable. The disposable numbers will still be available.
- Two options are available for show catalogues: 1) Catalogues can be emailed free of charge to exhibitors; or 2) Printed catalogues are available on the day for a fee (nominate on entry form).
- Previously, show information has been returned to exhibitors via a stamped, self-addressed envelope. Members can nominate to receive this information via email or post.

CONDITIONS

- All ponies must be registered with the Australian Miniature Pony Soc. Inc. and owned by current financial members
- All exhibitors/handlers must be financial members of the Australian Miniature Pony Society Inc.
- Separate entry forms must be completed by each exhibitor/partnership
- Photocopies of registration papers (front & back) and membership cards must accompany all entries
- A stamped, self-addressed envelope (business size) must accompany each entry form (if email option not selected)
- Cheques/money orders made payable to the NSW Australian Miniature Pony Society Inc. **Any cheques that rebound will incur a \$20 penalty fee and the total entry fee is required to be paid whether the exhibitor competes or not.**
- Birth Certificates required for Junior and Senior Handler and Driver Classes
- **Entry fees will not be refunded after the closing date.**
- **No changes will be accepted after the 6.10.2018 regardless of the reason**
- Ponies 2 years old (actual) and over must be adult registered (as per the constitution) prior to competing
- All Stallions/Colts must be bitted and handled by exhibitors 18yrs & over
- All ponies must be measured prior to competing.
- The Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry without assigning any reason therefore
